Suspension of Property Binding Authority - New Business – Hurricane Ike

Due to the impending approach of Hurricane Ike, **ALL New Business binding authority is temporarily suspended for all Property, Homeowners, Garage Physical Damage, and Inland Marine business.** We ask that you immediately advise all of your agency personnel of this suspension.

PLEASE NOTE: A major change from our past bulletins is that you cannot bind business even if you have excluded Wind & Hail.

Century Insurance Group will honor renewal accounts that are effective during this suspension period.

Ike is still a Category 2 storm with winds of 100 MPH, but is expected to strengthen into a Category 3 storm with winds of 111 to 130 MPH before landfall. The weather model shows Ike could hit anywhere along the north-central coast of Texas.
